

Seaforth Broomball League – November 18, 2019

Call to Order: President Brad Van Bakel called the meeting to order at 8:03 p.m.

Teams Present: All teams were represented except the Snipers and Royals. Also present were Georgina Reynolds and Connie Smith. Georgina was contact by Matt Shortreed saying he was not going to be at the meeting. Lisa Van Bakel was away (see last month's notes).

Treasure's Report: Lisa Van Bakel was away and asked Georgina to distribute the payments for refs and timekeepers this week (this payment was adjusted as one game was cancelled). Georgina also reminded teams that fees need to be paid by November 25, 2019. \$3800 for registration fees have been paid (this is the \$475 for each team).

Corbin has the sheets for this week as Georgina will be away. Georgina also requested the registration sheets, which were given to the team reps to get signatures, be handed in to Corbin this week.

The Juniors will not be running a food booth this year at the tournament.

Someone needs to be the Statistician for the Seaforth Broomball League. Dave Bolinger volunteered Denzel Bolinger to do this.

House Rules—changes are being made to the Coed Division house rules. It will read that no more than 2 consecutive goals can be scored by a male before a female must score. No maximum number of goals for males as long as it has been reset by a female scoring. Examples are 2 males score then a female must score to reset it, or a male scores then a female scores so it resets that 2 males can score after. This was agreed upon by the Ice Guardians, Slushies and Assassins to change the rules. All members of the executive were in agreement as well. Georgina Reynolds will update the House Rules.
