The goalie will be asked to take it off and a delay of game penalty will be given if not changed before game time. This is in the rules—Article #29 and Article #106 section B.

Eighteen teams are participating in Provincials. Entry fee is \$500 and teams to pay cheque to CWOBA or cash to Central West.

Regionals—Entry fee is \$350 (Co-ed teams pay \$175 as there is only 2 teams entered). Please make sure players have photo ID or two pieces of ID with them. There was a discussion regarding the Regionals weekend. It was asked if we can put divisions in one weekend to help with peoples work schedules. Regionals will continue to be the Saturday and Sunday of the first weekend and the Saturday of the second weekend to balance a schedule for all divisions. There was an outline to look over and will be used as a guide for creating Regionals schedules.
